**Crémant de Bourgogne, Brut Rosé, Louis Bouillot** **£15.00**  
Rose pink in colour, with fine bubbles and a light mousse. Perfumes of blackcurrant and strawberry follow through to a fine, ripe fruit on the palate, balanced freshness with a lingering hint of strawberries.

## Champagne

**Pol Roger, Brut, NV** ✓ **£21.00**  
Delicate aromas of brioche, citrus and white flowers lead to a creamy, rounded palate with hints of stone fruit and toast, lifted by fresh, lively acidity and a long, elegant finish.

**Pol Roger, Rose, 2016** ✓ **£40.00**  
Delicate pink in colour with fine, persistent bubbles, it offers aromas of wild strawberries, raspberries and rose petals. The palate is fresh and refined leading to a long, graceful finish.

**Salon, 2013** **£300.00**  
A prestigious Blanc de Blancs Champagne from Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, showing aromas of white flowers, citrus, and chalky minerality. The palate is rich, precise, and elegant, with baked apple, toasted hazelnut, and a long, mineral-driven finish.

A sophisticated white Bordeaux with aromas of citrus, white peach, and subtle floral notes. The palate is round and balanced, showing crisp acidity, gentle oak influence, and a long, mineral-driven finish.

A richly textured white Rioja, barrel-fermented for added depth and complexity. Aromas of ripe pear, citrus and vanilla lead to a creamy, well-balanced palate with subtle notes of spice and toasted oak, finishing fresh and elegant.

A delicate Provence rosé with aromas of wild strawberry, rose petals, and citrus blossom. The palate is fresh and elegant, displaying red berry fruit, subtle herbal notes, and a crisp, refreshing finish.

A powerful yet elegant red from Ribera del Duero, offering aromas of black cherry, plum, and subtle spice. The palate is rich and structured, with ripe dark fruit, fine-grained tannins, and a long, expressive finish.

**Grenache/Syrah, 'The Gypsy', Ken Forrester, Stellenbosh, South Africa £23.00**

A vibrant Grenache/Syrah blend with aromas of ripe red berries, plum, and subtle spice. The palate is juicy and approachable, showing soft tannins, bright fruit, and a smooth, lingering finish.

**Rully 1er, 'Clos du Chapitre', Jager-Defaix, Burgundy, France ✓ £24.00**

Barrel aged in oak, this Pinot Noir is intensely perfumed with lifted savoury notes interlaced with dark cherries, plum and cracked black pepper. The tannins are soft and silky, layered with plush, ripe red fruits, with a smooth elegant finish.

## Rhône Valley

### Northern Rhône

## Beaujolais

## Jura

Most famous is Vin Jaune, an age-worthy, nutty wine made from Savagnin, aged under flor-like yeast and rooted in centuries of tradition.

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## South of France

Stretching from the Spanish border to the Italian coast, the South of France encompasses a vast and diverse winemaking landscape. ### Haut Médoc

Located on the left bank of the Gironde, the Haut-Médoc is home to many of Bordeaux's most celebrated estates. Its patchwork of gravelly topsoil over clay, chalk, and limestone provides ideal drainage and vine health—crucial for producing structured, age-worthy reds. Only wines grown on these classic terroirs qualify for the appellation, with those on more fertile, river-adjacent soils excluded. Cabernet Sauvignon dominates, lending power, depth, and longevity to the region's wines.
